The verb that means "to go" in Spanish is _____

This **irregular** verb conjugates a little differently. You will need to _____ its conjugations.

Yo		Nosotros(as)	
TÚ		Vosotros(as)	
Él Ella Usted		Ellos(as) Ustedes	

***IMPORTANT NOTE: Just like "Yo hablo" = "I speak" AND "I am speaking"
"Yo voy" = "I go" AND "I am going"**

Now that you can conjugate "ir", you can also translate these phrases:

1. We go/We are going _____
2. He goes/He is going _____
3. You go/You are going _____
4. They go/They are going _____
5. Y'all (Spain) go/are going _____

**~The preposition _____ is used after the verb ir and means "to".
_____ is also used after jugar when saying someone plays a sport.**

Examples: -Yo voy a la casa de mi amigo.
-Yo juego a los videojuegos.

When "a" is followed by "el" (the), the two words combine to form the contraction _____. (a+el → "al")

Example: -Yo voy al cine. (a+el cine)
-Yo juego al béisbol. (a+el béisbol)
