Verb Boot:

1. Decorate the boot on the paper to make it more interesting.

FRONT:

- 2. In the boot, write the label "Boot verbs."
- 3. Inside the boot, create columns with the labels, (IE), (I), and (UE).
- 4. Divide the verbs listed into (IE) boot verbs, (I) boot verbs, and (UE) boot verbs.
- 5. Write the verbs that go under each category and conjugate them.

BACK:

- 1. On the back of your boot, write the label "NOT Boot Verbs."
- 2. Under that, make columns for Irregular verbs, Verbs with Irregular Yo forms, and Irregulars that kind of look like boot verbs.
- 3. Divide the verbs that are not true boot verbs into: "Irregulars,", "Verbs with Irregular Yo forms", and "Irregulars (that kind of look like boot verbs but aren't)."
- 4. Write the verbs that go under each column and conjugate them.

Here are the verbs you should divide up and conjugate:

Entender, Empezar, Probar, Pedir, Poder, Poner, Almorzar, Hacer, Traer, Salir, Ir, Ser, Venir, Tener, Estar, Dormir, Calentar, Preferir, Servir, Querer. Jugar, Saber
