Gender and adjective agreement

- Nouns and pronouns that refer to men and boys are **masculine**.
amigo él Alejandro
- Nouns and pronouns that refer to women and girls are **feminine**.
amiga ella Adriana
- Adjectives describe nouns. They have different forms that match the gender of a noun or pronoun.
Masculine: Alejandro es alto. Feminine: Adriana es alta.
- Adjectives that end in **-e** and most adjectives that end in a **consonant** have the same masculine and feminine forms.
Él es intelectual/inteligente. Ella es intelectual/inteligente.
- Exceptions: Adjectives that end in **-or** and adjectives of nationality that end in a consonant form the feminine by adding an **-a**.
Él es trabajador. Ella es trabajadora.

Number and adjective agreement

- **Singular** adjectives describe one person. **Plural** adjectives describe more than one.
- If the singular form ends in a **vowel**, add **-s** to make it plural: **altos**.
- If the singular form ends in a **consonant**, add **-es** to make it plural: **intelectuales**.
- Describe **mixed groups** with masculine plural forms: **Pablo y Sarita son cómicos.**
